Supporting Document (Required)

Attach an official transcript of grades showing cumulative work completed in high school (high school applicants) or college (college applicants).

The HHS Alumni Association annually awards scholarships to graduating seniors who rank in the upper half of their high school class (unless otherwise noted). Any HHS graduate currently attending college may also apply. The HHS Alumni Association has the right to reject any application. Successful applicants must be of good moral character and have a firmness of purpose. Financial need may also be considered.

Jerry D. Carey Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of the former Hutsonville CUSD #1 Superintendent and LTC Dean of Students. An eligible student must plan to pursue a course of study at Lincoln Trail College and possess a high school GPA of at least at 3.0 and be of high integrity. All other above-listed criteria must also be met. Award amount is \$300.00.

Gene Dolson Mathematics Scholarship: Given in memory of Gene Dolson, HHS Class of '44, longtime HHS mathematics teacher and principal, and Eastern Illinois University mathematics professor. An eligible student must meet the above-listed criteria and plan to enter the field of teaching mathematics at the junior high or high school level or pursue a career in elementary education. Award amount is \$500.

Ciara Frost Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of HHS student Ciara Frost, who would have graduated as a member of the Class of 2009. One or two scholarships totaling \$1,000.00 will be awarded to a student pursuing a career in teaching. If no teaching candidate applies, second priority will be given to a student planning to pursue study in a health or sports-related career (coaching, athletic training, etc.). Should no suitable candidate apply based on these criteria, preference will be given to a student who has a high GPA and participated fully in athletics at HHS. All other above-listed criteria must also be met.

Austin Grant Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Austin Grant, HHS Class of 2006 and student at Lincoln Technical Institute. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria and plan to pursue a career at a technical school. Preference will be given to potential diesel mechanics majors. Award amount is \$500 (\$1,000 if the student attends Lincoln Technical Institute).

Alberta Heber Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Alberta Heber, longtime member of the Hutsonville farming community. One scholarship will be awarded to a female student pursuing a vocational degree. All other above-listed criteria must also be met. Award amount is \$500.

William Heber Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of William Heber, former member of the Hutsonville Board of Education. An eligible student must plan to pursue a course of study in agriculture or a vocational technology program. All other above-listed criteria must also be met. Award amount is \$500.

Nancy Rains Hellman Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Nancy (Rains) Hellmann, HHS Class of '66, a former Hutsonville Grade School teacher. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria and plan to pursue a career in special education or elementary education. Amount is \$500.

HHS Alumni Association Scholarships: Individual award amounts vary based on the number of deserving applicants and their financial need. Eligible students must meet the above-listed criteria.

Tom & Kay Kraemer Honorary Scholarships: Given in Honor of Tom (Class of 1952) & Kay Kraemer, HHS Business Teacher. Preference will be given in the awarding of this \$1,000 scholarship to a student who plans to pursue a career in business or business education. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria.

Charles A. "Doc" Layton Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of the HHS graduate and Hutsonville Grade School Teacher and Principal who served the students of the Hutsonville area from 1914-1960. This scholarship is will be awarded to a student

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who possesses a GPA of 2.00-2.99 and demonstrates financial need. Eligible students must also meet the above-listed general criteria. Award amount is \$750.

Hershel and Hazel Musgrave Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Hershel (HHS Class of '20) and his wife, Hazel. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria. Award amount is \$500.

Greg Newlin Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Greg Newlin, HHS Class of '64 and longtime art teacher in Illinois schools. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria and plan to pursue a career in art or music. Preference will be given to potential art majors. Award amount is \$500.

Janet R. Noblitt Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Janet (Ridgway) Noblitt '72, longtime HHS Math Teacher. To qualify for this \$1000 scholarship, eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria. Preference will be given to a student who plans to pursue a career in teaching mathematics or in a math-related field.

Russell and Audra Rains Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Russell Rains, HHS Class of '24 and former Hutsonville School Board Member and his wife, Audra. Scholarship is sponsored by their daughters, Sandra and Mary Jo. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria. Award amount is \$500.

Susan Rains Sprenkle Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Susan (Rains) Sprenkle, HHS Class of 1958. Preference will be given in the awarding of this \$500 scholarship to a student who plans to pursue a career in business, business education or music. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria.

Wilbur Reynolds Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Wilbur Reynolds, HHS Class of 1948. Preference will be given in the awarding of this \$500 scholarship to a student who plans to pursue a career in agriculture or a vocational program and has GPA of 2.00-2.99. Eligible students must meet the above-listed general criteria.

Gene Gower Engineering Scholarship: Given by Gene Gower, Class of 1990, to promote interest in the engineering and sciences field. Preference will be given to a student pursuing a degree in engineering. If no engineering student is eligible, preference will be given to a student pursuing a degree in education. Award amount is \$500.00.

Roger L. and Becca Brooks Eddy Scholarship: Given to a student pursuing a degree in secondary education or a career that works directly with children. Award amount is \$1,000.00.

Gary D. Matteson Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of the former Hutsonville CUSD#1 Superintendent. Eligible students must meet the above listed criteria. Award amount is \$500.00.

Zylpha M. Rains Educational Scholarship: Given in memory of Zylpha M. (Hathaway) Rains, HHS Class of 1928 and a former teacher at Hutsonville Grade School. Zylpha was also awarded the Distinguished Alumni Award in 1999. Eligible students must meet the above listed criteria with preference given to a student pursuing a career in elementary education. Award amount is \$500.00.

Lucas E. Mehler Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Luke Mehler, Class of 2010, by his parents, Doc and Tracy, brothers, Jake and Logan, (all whom are also graduates of HHS) as well as his sister-in-law Sammy and nephews, Radlee, Ruxin and Rafe. Preference is given to a male athlete from Hutsonville High School or Palestine High School who exhibits leadership, sportsmanship and competitiveness on and off the field. Award amount is \$1,000.00

Coach Don "Butch" Rees Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Coach Don "Butch" Rees, former Hutsonville High School coach and business teacher. This scholarship is given by his family to an eligible athlete. All athletes are eligible but priority is given to those who plan on pursuing secondary education in the field of business. Awards amount is \$500.00.

Farmers & Merchants Bank of Hutsonville Scholarships: The bank began awarding \$1,000.00 in scholarship money annually through the Alumni Association in 1995. We continue to offer these scholarships to increase public awareness of locally owned banks and their contributions to the community while also recognizing HHS graduates who have chosen to further their education. Two scholarships will be given in the amount of \$500.00 each.

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
